## **NOTICES TO COMPETITORS**

## Notice 5 5/6/2022 NEW COURSE LAYOUT FOR MAY 7 – RACES 5 & 6

Races 5 & 6 will be held Saturday May 7, conditions permitting. The race committee intends to test a recommendation from the membership, moving the start/finish line for these races to the leeward mark, rather than placing it in the middle of the leg from the leeward mark to the windward mark.

The leeward mark will function as both a rounding mark for courses and the pin end of the start/finish line. The mark will be an orange tetrahedron.

Finishes will be <u>downwind</u> finishes, crossing the line from the course side of the line. At the finish, boats are <u>NOT</u> to round leeward mark and finish upwind.

Courses will be displayed on the signal boat course board. For example a windward leeward, twice around course will be displayed as <u>A C A F</u>.

A course displayed as <u>A C A F</u> means that competitors will start, sail to and round the weather mark (Mark A) leaving it to port, sail to and round the leeward mark (Mark C) leaving it to port, sail to and round the weather mark leaving it to port and then sail between the leeward mark and the committee signal boat from the direction of the windward mark to finish.

Another course could include a reaching mark and only be a once around course. The course board would show **A B F**.

This course would mean that competitors will start, sail to and round the windward mark leaving it to port, sail to and round the reaching mark (Mark B) leaving it to port and then sail between the leeward mark and the committee signal boat from the direction of the reaching mark to finish.

This course setup will be described at the skippers' meeting at 12:00 PM on May 7<sup>th</sup>, and the race committee will answer questions if there are any.

# Notice 3 4/27/2022 REVISED PROCEDURES FOR SIGN-IN, CHECK-IN AND WITHDRAWING FROM A RACE

- 1) For all future BYRA events, a sign-in sheet will be available at the skippers' meeting. Please check the details we have listed for your boat and initial the sign-in sheet in the appropriate column.
- 2) On the water, when the Come Within Hail flag is raised, please check-in with the Race Committee signal boat, stating your sail number and whether you will sail with or without a spinnaker.

- 3) Between races, please ONLY check-in with the signal boat if you are changing between using a spinnaker or not using a spinnaker.
- 4) If you withdraw from a race either during the race or before a start please notify the race committee as soon as possible.
